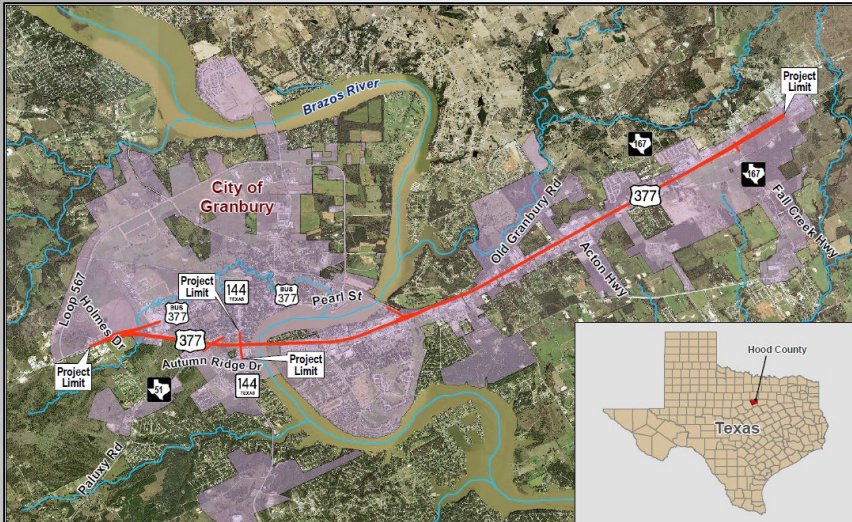


US 377 IN HOOD COUNTY PROJECT

FORT WORTH DISTRICT



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Highway/Limits: US 377 from Holmes Drive to 3,000 feet north of FM 167 (Fall Creek Highway), including SH 144 from Autumn Ridge Road to FM 51 (Paluxy Road) in the City of Granbury, Hood County, Texas

Project CSJs: 0080-04-081, 0080-03-049, 0080-04-094 and 0080-03-060

Project Length: Approximately 9 miles

Description: The proposed project design would reconstruct and widen US 377 from a four-lane divided highway to a six-lane divided highway with a raised, concrete median. The project would plan for adding capacity to US 377 from Holmes Drive to 3,000 feet north of FM 167, and would improve cross street interchanges, ramps and driveway connections. The proposed project also includes the addition of shared-use paths in each direction for bicycle and pedestrian accommodations and drainage improvements along the corridor. A breakout project for early implementation is planned to include improvements to the US 377/SH 144 interchange from FM 51 to the north end of the Brazos River Bridge, and SH 144 from Autumn Ridge Road to FM 51.

Funding: \$25 million has been identified for the breakout project.

Estimated Construction Dosts: Breakout Project – Approximately \$38 million
Ultimate Project – Approximately \$95 million (excluding the breakout project)
