Location: Original Location

-One story frame structure

-Center passage plan (one room deep)

-Pier and beam foundation

-Synthetic (vinyl) siding

-One bay, west elevation porch with gable roof, square posts, jig-sawn brackets, and turned work frieze

-Wood sash, double hung windows (1/1)

-Single door primary entrance

-Gable end treatments same as wall surface with vents

-Gable roof with composition shingles and exposed rafter ends
