The following are guidelines for booth operators at the event:

- Include some type of game or activity at your booth
- Promotional items and giveaways are encouraged
- No buying or selling of goods, as this is a free community event
- Booth operators must supply their own tables, chairs, tablecloths, and tents
- Must be setup at Softball Field #4 at Granbury City Park by 10:30 am on April 8
