

## Historic Landmark #31



### **Daniel-Harris House 403 W. Bridge Street**

Built in 1892 by Robert Randolph Daniel (1864-1918), this home features an ornate square tower and intricate ornamentation. Daniel, a Granbury saloonkeeper, sold the home in 1899 to Wesley Smith Harris (1854-1930), a prominent local furniture dealer and undertaker. This Victorian era residence is a good example of Queen Anne style architecture with influences of Italianate and Eastlake styles. The home received a state historic landmark designation in 1981.
