

RESOLUTION NO. 21-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANBURY, TEXAS, CALLING A RUNOFF ELECTION FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNCILPERSON PLACE FIVE (5) AND ESTABLISHING THE DATES AND TIMES OF EARLY VOTING FOR SUCH ELECTION IN ACCORDANCE TO THE CONTRACT WITH HOOD COUNTY TO FURNISH ELECTION SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 21-03 of the City of Granbury, Texas, adopted on May 10, 2021 and Resolution No. 21-04 of the City of Granbury, Texas, adopted on May 14, 2021, a special election was duly held on June 29, 2021, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, Place One (1) and Councilperson, Place Five (5) to fill the remainder of the unexpired three (3) year terms, or until the successors have been duly qualified; and,

WHEREAS, the official results of said election were canvassed with the adoption of Resolution No. 21-08 on July 6, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 11, Section 11b of the Texas Constitution and Section 2.021 of the Texas Election Code, a runoff election is required for the purpose of electing a Councilperson Place Five (5); and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2.025(a) of the Texas Election Code, a runoff election must be held not earlier than the 20th day and not later than the 45th day after the final canvass of the main election is complete; and

WHEREAS, the Hood County Elections Administrator as set out in the Contract for Election Services signed and approved on May 10, 2021, will furnish election services and equipment to hold the said runoff election.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANBURY, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1.

The City Council of the City of Granbury, Texas, hereby orders a runoff election for the City of Granbury, Texas, to be held on July 27, 2021, for the purpose of electing a Councilperson Place Five (5) to fill the remainder of the unexpired three (3) year term, or until the successor has been duly qualified. Pursuant to Section 2.023 of the Texas Election Code, the candidates in a runoff election are the candidates who receive the highest and second highest number of votes in the main election or who tie for the highest number of votes.

SECTION 2.

Michele Carew, Hood County Elections Administrator, 1410 West Pearl Street, Granbury, Texas 76048, is hereby appointed as Early Voting Clerk and General Custodian of the Election Materials until the time required by law has lapsed. Furthermore, the Hood County Elections Administrator is authorized to contact Election Judges and Alternate Judges who are hereby appointed as identified in the Contract for Election Services approved on May 10, 2021. The Contract for Election Services shall provide (a) all election supplies and equipment to be used for early voting by personal appearance and on election day, (b) notification and training for election judges and clerks, (c) an estimate and final payment terms for the election services provided, (d) agreements for early voting equipment and voting machine rental, and (e) other procedures to conduct the election.

SECTION 3.

Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at Hood County Annex 1, 1410 West Pearl Street, Granbury, Texas 76048, during the following hours and dates:

- July 12-16, 2021 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- July 19, 2021 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- July 20, 2021 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
- July 21, 2021 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- July 22, 2021 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
- July 23, 2021 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

SECTION 4.

All resident, qualified voters, determined by the laws of the State of Texas, the Charter and ordinances of the City of Granbury shall be qualified to vote at such election. Voting on Election Day, July 27, 2021, shall be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. at Hood County Annex 1, 1410 West Pearl Street, Granbury, Texas 76048.

SECTION 5.

The results of the election shall be certified, canvassed, and returned in the form and manner prescribed by the laws of the State of Texas and the Charter and ordinances of the City of Granbury.

SECTION 6.

The notice of the election hereby ordered and called shall be promulgated, published and posted in keeping with the laws of the State of Texas, and the Charter and ordinances of the City of Granbury.

SECTION 7.

The City Manager and the City Secretary, in consultation with the City Attorney, are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to comply with the provisions of Federal and State law in carrying out and conducting the election, whether or not expressly authorized herein.
