EV Rebates Expires January 7! Don't Miss Out!

Granbury, Texas – The Texas electric vehicle rebate ([Texas Light-Duty Motor Vehicle Purchase or Lease Incentive Program](#)) is expiring on **Jan. 7, 2021!** This incentive is applicable to new electric drive (Battery electric or plug-in hybrid) vehicles, to get up to **\$2500** back. Any EV owner who purchased or leased their vehicle **between Sept. 1, 2019 through Jan. 7, 2021** is eligible to apply.

Of the 2,000 grants originally offered, 871 rebate grants remain to be used. In order for funds to not go to waste, we are reaching out to help circulate and encourage the applications of this available free money. For more information on how to apply, visit
